By Road

1. From Guwahati to Imphal via Dimapur (NH -39).
2. From Silchar to Imphal via Jiribam (NH -53).

By Air

is located close to the royal palace. This interesting structure with its twin domes has a paved courtyard and a great assembly hall where devotees congregate to participate in various devotional activities.



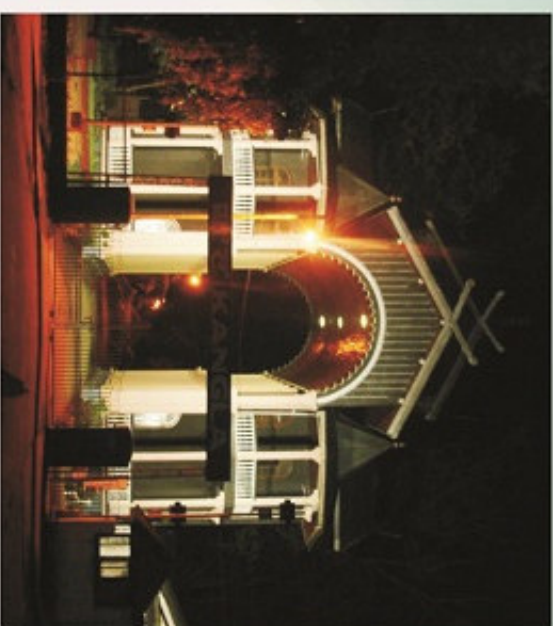
